Secretary's Report: Minutes of secretary's report were approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Poe reported that we have \$5109.58 in the treasury.

OLD BUSINESS

The Alumni Association will send another email invitation for the May 31 Scholarship Banquet to alumni in our area. Neila will also send a separate email to club members only. Gene reported that we had 20 people volunteer at Matthew 25, our April volunteer project. We worked for 1 hour 45 minutes and went on a tour of Global Village. The Alumni Association gave all the volunteers an Ohio State volunteer shirt and is reimbursing us for lunch at Panera's after the event.

Monica and Marla were nominated by Cheryl for one of the Alumni Awards. Cheryl submitted the diversity application in March. Monica and Marla have written a curriculum on diversity in which they speak to educators and various groups about their program throughout the country. OSU has

adopted their curriculum for all incoming freshmen. Monica and Cheryl are working together to put together the application for Alumni Club of the year award. This is a way for our club to gain recognition for all of our work with different social and educational events as well as our fundraising activities that we sponsor each year. This application is due by June 30.
