President Cheryl Long called the meeting to order. Present were: Cheryl Long, Judy and Al Karchner, Bob Poe, Karen and Marvin Stotz, Neila and Bruce Barnes, Dave Banker, and Fran and Gene Elleman.

Secretary's Report: The secretary's report was approved as corrected. The date of the Penn State game was changed to September 29.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Poe reported that we have \$7,639.74 in the treasury.

Endowment Update: On June 30, 2017 we had \$88,840. in the endowment fund. The current value as of August 18, 2019 is \$90,216.

OLD BUSINESS

Karen discussed the communication problems we and other alumni clubs experienced with the Summer Sent Off Picnic. The Alumni Association understands the issue and plans to target the announcements specific to each club to make it easier to register.

Gene reported that thirty people are registered and paid for the September 29 Ohio State-Penn State game and bus trip with Reynold's Travel. Fifteen of the 30 are first time travelers with us.

NEW BUSINESS

Cheryl, Karen, Marvin, Gene and Fran all gave recaps from the breakout sessions they attended at the recent Alumni Association Leadership Symposium. We discussed ideas to try to attract new members and involve current members. Our club was awarded \$2000 for qualifying for Scarlet level and received an award certificate. We are looking forward to celebrating our university's sesquicentennial celebration in 2020.

Cheryl reported that Mallory Greenham, our corresponding secretary, will continue to sending out notices via Mail Chimp.

Jonathan Hlavac, a financial planner, will a present Life Long Learning Program on Retirement Income Planning from 6:15 to 6:45 at our next meeting, October 10 at the Olive Garden in Middletown.

A few new people expressed an interest in having a TCU game watch party. Cheryl will send out an email to members if it she finds a convenient location. Karen is planning the Michigan State November 10 football game watch party at Frickers in West Chester.

Gene reported that individual tickets go on sale Oct. 19 for basketball games. There is a basketball game double header on December 2 for both women and men. The women play the University of Cincinnati at 2:00pm and the men play Minnesota at 7:00pm. If there is enough interest we will place some group tickets on hold for both games which members and friends can then purchase.

Karen reported that our tentative Voice of America reservation for the December 5 Christmas party is being held until September 13. There has been some dissatisfaction with the VOA location in recent years because of problems with limited caterers so we will investigate other locations. Since attendance has been dwindling in recent years we're considering skipping the Christmas party this year. The total expenses for this event last year was \$733.38. This qualifies as a Networking event; the association reimburses us \$500.

Cheryl developed an extensive list of possible venues for next year's spring scholarship banquet. Several members volunteered to obtain details on a few of them and report their findings at the next meeting. Marvin suggested that we obtain business cards to hand out to local alumni and friends of Ohio State. Cheryl added that small magnets with our schedule of events would be a good way publicize and encourage alumni to join our activities. Bob Poe made a motion and Marvin seconded that Cheryl follow up with university approved vendors. Motion passed.


